Sir, I beg to enclose you herewith duplicate of my respects of the 16th ultimo.

The "Mariner" will not leave before the 27th Inst when I hope to embark about 48 (souls) Emigrant on account of the Emigration Commissioners, since my last, replies have been received from

Johann SIGGELKOW who agrees to go - No.16
Joachim NEWMAN & family ditto - No.45 & 50
Henrich SEEMAN & family decline to go owing to illness of his parents No.60, 62
Hans BOCKMANN & family decline to go at present - No.54 & 59

No further replies received from the others.

On the sailing of the "Mariner" complete lists shall be forwarded, together with all documents required by the Commissioners. I have the Honor to be Sir, Your most obedient servant.
