Sacred to the memory of Francis Drake died 18<sup>th</sup> May 1861 in his 45<sup>th</sup> year. Also of Elizabeth his widow who died in Edinburgh on the 5<sup>th</sup> July 1898 in her 82<sup>nd</sup> year and of Francis their youngest son who died in London 11<sup>th</sup> January 1897 in his 48<sup>th</sup> year and also of Ellen their youngest daughter, wife of the Revd Joseph Wren, M. A., who died there, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> April 1883 in her 26<sup>th</sup> year and was buried here on the 27<sup>th</sup> September 1883 and of Mary third daughter of the above Francis and Elizabeth Drake who died in Edinburgh on the 29<sup>th</sup> February 1904 in her 53<sup>rd</sup> year.
