Mentions wife Susanna; Nieces Elizabeth Aldret and Hannah Aldret; Brother-in-laws Samuel Mewis and Richard Brown; John Coxon  
Also Brother-in-law James Mewis and his second son William  
Witnessed by William Brown, John Mewis and John Woolley
