This is the last will and testament of me Thomas Hoseman of Wellington I give my watch to my sister - All the rest of my property whatsoever and wheresoever I give to my mother if she be alive. Should my mother be dead then I give all my property except the watch given as aforesaid ~~given~~ to my sister I give to my brother and sister to be divided between them share and share alike I make Joseph Boulcott of Wellington my executor and declare this to be my last will dated the eighteenth day of May one thousand eight hundred and forty six.
