Taita April 20, 1871. Sir, I have the honor to report that Lieutenant Welch had not an opportunity of completing his number of drills owing to his being in Auckland as a Representative in the late Colonial prize firing. I have the honor to be Sir, your most obedient servant, William Whitewood, Captain commanding, Taita Rifle Volunteers.

Taita April 21, 1871. Sir, I have the honor to report that member George Gaskin who has performed two drills in the Wairarapa district certifies, that he was unable to complete his last drill owing to wet weather, having upon two occasions walked a distance of ten miles there being no drill either time in consequence of bad weather. I have the honor to be Sir, your most obedient servant, William Whitewood, Captain commanding, Taita Rifle Volunteers.
