1845/18 Feb 06 Debentures issued at Wellington, counterparts returned

1845/30 Aug 05 Advising transmission of original accounts through Collector of Customs
1845/31 Aug 23 Acknowledging receipt of debentures and asking about interest thereon
1845/32 Jun 27 Re fourteen colonial fund debentures
1845/33 Jun 27 Acknowledging receipt of 500 Government debentures
1845/35 Aug 29 Returning audit queries
1845/36 Sep 22 For supply of forms, interest credit vouchers and others
1845/37 Sep 22 Acknowledging receipt of remittance per 'Lady Leigh' of £5,500
1845/38 Sep 22 Re Mr Macarthy's salary as Harbour Master from 1st to 6th Jan 1845
- 1845/39 Oct 02
Acknowledging receipt of remittance per 'Victoria' of £1,500; reporting transmission to Nelson of £250
- 1845/40 Oct 07
Respecting amounts of property rates omitted to be brought to charge; reference to the case of McLennan (then deceased) and that the estate was not liable for property rates
- 1845/41 Oct 09
Duplicates of letters per 'Falco' –copy of a letter dated 07 Jul 1845 regarding a double payment of the property rate by George Cole
- 1845/42 Oct 09 Estimate of amount required to meet demands on the Sub Treasurer
- 1845/43 Nov 27
Replies to audit queries – property rate notices sent to George Clarke Jnr, Protector of Aboriginies and T. E. Taylor of HM Customs
- 1845/44 Oct 10
Forwarding accounts for a Stamp & Postage – mentions Joseph Marriott for making and furnishing a stamp for the purpose of stamping debentures...

1845/45 Nov 19

Advising transmission of accounts – also that £3 of debentures were retired from circulation on being defaced

1845/46 Nov 26

Amount in hand & estimate of sums required... PS I will make a point if needful to arrange for the paying the whole or the greater portion of the £165 for Akaroa to Mr Watson before he sails, to prevent undue inconvenience to Mr Robinson who is about to leave Akaroa.
