His home in England is The Stamford Arms Hotel, Bowden, Altrincham, Manchester, England. Was of medium height and had hazel eyes. His wife (who was a Belgian Refugee) whom he married during war time has asked me to make enquiries for her as she is unable to write or read English very well. She was informed of his death in 1920 but doubts its accuracy. Should be glad of any information whatever concerning the above. Thanking you in anticipation, yours faithfully Mrs L. Bailey.
